- History of co-operation since 2009

- Master of International and Comparative Law -program of ULapland
- Two specializations
 - Arctic Law and Governance
 - Transcultural Business Law
- Based on structure of Modules (30 ECTS each)



Degree Structure

- General component, 30 ECTS
- Special component, 30 ECTS
- Development of Expertise, 30 ECTS
 - Can be done at home
- Bridging (max 30 ECTS) if needed
- First application spring 2012
- First students starts at the autumn 2012
