- Multidisciplinary two-year programme (120
 ECTS/60 NA) approaching Circumpolar Health and Wellbeing as a holistic phenomenon
 - Relationship between environment societal factors human health and wellbeing
- Students will be awarded Master of Health Sciences from University of Oulu
- MCH graduates will work as professionals in administrative and managerial positions in health care services, health promotion, education, development, planning and research
- Possibility to continue to PhD programs



Circumpolar health and wellbeing

- First students started in Jan 2009 (Univ Oulu)
- 11 students (FIN, AUS, CAN, RUS, UK)
- Coordinator: Centre for Arctic Medicine at Thule Institute,
 & Institute of Health Sciences, University of Oulu, Finland

- Took effect in Feb 2008
- Signed by the principal and consulting partner institutions

- A supplement to the Agreement defining learning outcomes, student admission and other practical matters
- Signed by the principal partner institutions (March 2010)

Future aspects

- Economical issues (extra money for exchange of the students and teachers, seminars), fees?
- Principal partners, not more than 10 (seeking possible partners from Iceland, Alaska, Norway)
- Associating partners, now e.g. Univ Alberta, Univ Toronto, Charles Darwin Univ (agreements of collaboration between universities) - e.g. suitable on-line/face to face courses (in English), supervision
- Development of the tracks
- Collaboration with other Master's and PhD health programs in circumpolar area (e.g. Public health in Univ of Alaska, Anchorage, Univ of Tromso) and Univ Arctic
- Development of PhD studies (Univ Oulu, Univ Arctic), joint summer schools
