


### **Cornerstones of Arctic Research**

  - research in human rights and environmental law in the Arctic




## **Arctic Palette of Universities**

- International Secretariat in Rovaniemi




## **Portrayal of Law**

  - brings out different meanings of home in the structure of society, in everyday life, and in relationships between individuals, local communities, and families




